

Upper Roxbury Sewer Separation Phase 3

Project Update

BWSC Contract: 17-309-011

PURPOSE

Roxbury Sewer Separation Phase 3 is a continuation of the work recently completed on Dudley Street and involves the separation of the combined sewer system into a new sewer system and new drain system. This project will reduce pollution levels in Boston Harbor by substantially decreasing the number and volume of combined sewer overflows. This project will also include some water main replacement work as well. The purpose of this notice is to provide information regarding the ongoing improvements in your neighborhood and any necessary impacts or disruptions that might result from this work.

COMPLETED WORK

- ➤ <u>Blue Hill Avenue:</u> Dudley St. to Dewey St.
- Copeland Street: Moreland St. to Langford Pk.
- ➤ Moreland Street: Blue Hill Ave. to #40 Moreland St.
- Perrin Street: Moreland St. to #30 Perrin St.
- Southwood Street: Blue Hill Ave to #72 Southwood St.
- Waverly Street: Blue Hill Ave to #26 Waverly St.
- Woodbine Street: Blue Hill Ave. to #35 Woodbine St.

UPCOMING & ONGOING WORK

- Blue Hill Avenue: Dewey St. to Maywood St.
 - o Install 200 LF of sewer and drain
- Julian Street: Dewey St. to Maywood St.
 - o Install 200 LF of sewer and drain
- Maywood Street: Blue Hill Ave. to #29 Maywood St.
 - o Install 730 LF of water main
- Brookford Street: Blue Hill Ave. to Rand St.
 - Install 350 LF of sewer and drain

ANTICIPATED IMPACTS


The anticipated impacts include water service interruptions, noise, traffic and parking modifications, rodent activity, dust, and general construction impacts. The contractor will be required to minimize impacts to the extent feasible.

Outbound traffic on Blue Hill Avenue will be detoured to facilitate the work.

SURFACE RESTORATION

Temporary restoration of roadways, sidewalks and other areas disturbed by construction will be completed under this contract. Permanent paving restoration will occur under a separate contract.
